




**Minutes of the Meeting held on 4.2.2013 at 11 A.M. under the Chairmanship of  
Joint Secretary (SE-II), regarding transfer of CTSA Schools to CTA.**

The Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of HRD, Government of India vide its letter No. 4-3/2002-UT.2/Sch.3, dated 18<sup>th</sup> January 2013 has conveyed the approval of the Government, to transfer the schools run by Central Tibetan School Administration (CTSA), to Central School Administration (CTA), Dharamshala. Consequently, a meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Shri Apurva Chandra, Joint Secretary (SE-II), on 4.2.2013 at 11 a.m., to work out the modalities for transferring the schools to CTA. The following members were present in the meeting:

All the members were briefed about the decision of the Government to transfer the school to CTA, Dharamshala. Shri A.S. Rawat, E.O., CTSA circulated the detail of options exercised by the employees of the CTSA, regarding their absorption in sister organization like KVS, CBSE, NCERT and NVS. After detailed deliberations, the following decisions have been taken :-

1. KVS, CBSE and NCERT agreed "in principle" for the transfer of CTSA employees to their organization, on absorption basis. However, in respect of some cadres like Shorthand & Typing Instructors, Work Experience Teachers, Lab Assistants and Tailoring Instructors, the organizations were directed to examine the RRs of these posts in CTSA with reference to the RRs of similar/equivalent posts in their organization, so that these employees could



be suitably accommodated. It was further stressed that in view of the decision of the Government to transfer the CTSA school to CTA, Dharamshala, the organizations may consider giving relaxation in educational qualification in respect of those posts which do not meet the educational qualification as prescribed in the RRs of these posts in KVS/CBSE/NCERT, after giving due weightage to the experience of the employees in CTSA. If required, a proposal in this regard may be placed before the Governing Body of the respective institute, for its consideration and approval.

2. It was noted that the actual transfer of CTSA employees will be staggered on the basis of handing over schedule of CTSA schools to CTA.
3. Some of the non-teaching CTSA employees have opted for joining NCERT (Headquarters). Since this option is not available as per the Government decision, the second option of these employees will be considered.
4. CBSE has agreed in "principle" for disbursing pension to the existing pensioners of CTSA. Hence, the pension liabilities of existing pensioners would be deducted from the grants to be released to CTA, after transfer of the schools, and provided to CBSE by MHRD. In case of employees of CTSA who are going to be absorbed in NCERT and KVS, their pro-rata pensionary benefit (LSPC etc.) need not be calculated and paid by CTSA to these organizations, as these organizations receive non-plan grant from MHRD. However, in case of employees who will be joining CBSE, their pension liabilities for the services rendered by them in CTSA will have to be calculated and paid by MHRD / CTSA to CBSE, as CBSE does not receive non-plan grant from the Ministry.
5. Employees, who will be joining NVS would be covered by the pension rules of NVS.
6. After examining the qualification of the employees of CTSA, the KVS, CBSE and NCERT will examine the RRs of the post against which they are to be absorbed and give their final comments/consent by 13<sup>th</sup> February 2013.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
